JULY 2008

DEPARTMENT OF COUNSELING

- Cases increased by 20
- Fifteen of the cases involves youth
- 12 of the cases are related to drug abuse.
- 9 of the clients were under 18 but above 15 years
- No previous case was terminated.

PLANS

- Continue the counseling sessions.

DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WORK

- Worked on the collections of clothes for widows and orphans.
- Visited 64 orphans and 42 widows.
- Distributed the items.
- Only 15 widows got a dress and 10 orphans got a single cloth since the items were few.
- Began to work on the plan to repair/fix widows houses to help them from rain which causes property damage, restless nights and sickness to the children.
- Began to work on December Youth and Women Empowerment Conference.

JUNE 2008

DEPARTMENT OF COUNSELING

- Counseling Cases rose again to 486
- Domestic Cases reduced to 114

- The remaining 372 were youth related.
- No case was terminated this month.

PLANS

- Continue the previous plans
- Plan for December women conference.
- Plans for December youth Conference.

DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WORK

- Stream cleaning programme was completed.
- A total of 42 streams have been cleaned for the community.

PLANS

- Plans to help repair widows houses beginning November

MAY 2008

DEPARTMENT OF COUNSELING

- Cases decreased to 480
- 30 cases were ended up well
- 264 of the current cases are youth related.

PLANS

- Continue the previous plans.
- Introduction of pre-Higher education counseling programme by August to prepare the youth who are just about to go for higher learning.

DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WORK

- 10 streams were cleaned up
- 20 orphans were visited

PLANS.

- Continue the previous tree planting plan.
- plan on how to improve the streams and create water resources.

MARCH 2008

THE DEPARTMENT OF COUNSELING

- We had 510 cases
- 230 cases involved women
- 200 cases involved youth
- 80 involved children
- 60 cases were ended well

PLANS

- Continue with the previous plans
- No new plan yet.

DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WORK

- Visited and comforted 60 orphans during Easter.
- Helped the widows in their farm/home work during the week after Easter.
- Helped in cleaning of community water streams
- Visited three high schools and talked with youth

PLANS

- Continue with the previous plans
- No new plan yet.

FEBRUARY 2008

THE DEPARTMENT OF COUNSELING

Counseling cases increased to 460 because of the violence and insecurity

(n.b. Oscar is referring to food and tangibles insecurity at the time when Kenya was politically unstable)

- 111 cases involved women and are domestic.
- 106 cases involved the youth.
- 74 of the above 106 cases were related to drugs.
- 164 involved women but were as a result of violence in the country
- 79 cases involved children and are violence related as well as domestic.

ARCHIEVEMENTS

- 50 cases were ended successfully.
- Admission reached 460 cases.

PLANS

- Continue the February programmes.
- Develop a new programme for child counseling.
- Creation of more peer support units to bring together clients.
- Developing activities to help in the healing process.

DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WORK

- Visited 60 orphans in various homes.
- Relocated the ten widows to their homes.
- Created 3 Anti-HIV/AIDS AND Violence units.

PLANS

- Continue the February programmes
- Develop More units to combat violence and HIV/AIDS.
- Initiate these programmes in schools and churches in the region.
- Plan for peace and reconciliation programmes which will involve training of church leaders, village elders and various other leaders.

JANUARY 2008

COUNSELING DEPARTMENT

- We were able to deal with 470 cases
- None of the cases was ended during this month because of the weight of this cases.
- 180 cases involve the youth and violence.
- 320 are social/violence related and involve mostly women.

PLANS.

- Continue the previous unfinished programmes.

- New plans will be in the month of February because of the current strains

DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WEL FARE

- Formed 20 more units for combating violence and drug abuse.
- 9 of them involve students in higher learning high schools.

- Continue with the previous programmes.
- New plans will be enhanced in February because of the current strains
